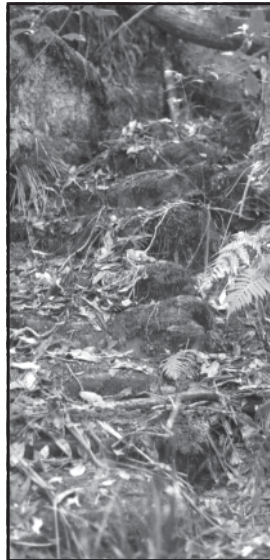


Old Western Track

Access: Suitable only for experienced bushwalkers. If attempting both sections start from Bedford Pool. The section between Terrace

Old Western Track

Falls and Picnic Point can be started from either end but it's easier to lose the track from the Terrace Falls end.

Features: 'Forgotten' old tracks — probably built in 1932 and 1937; stone step zigzag; satisfaction of going where few have gone for many years.

Length, Time & Rating: About 800 metres, 1 to 2 hours, *some steps, fallen trees and obscured track, difficult crossing of Bedford Creek, hard.*

The easiest place to start is from the 'triangular' rock described with Map 6 (Lester Pool). Stop on the first stone step and look to your right — here is your track heading upstream beside Bedford Creek. Fifty metres will bring you to an old fallen tree blocking your path. Down to your right is the original beginning of this track — ignore this. Scramble around the
